Electro pneumatic key and stop actions

Built by William Sweetland, with additions in 1906.

The church must downsize, and the organ will become redundant.

The console is at ground level at the east end, while the organ itself is housed in the organ loft at the west end of the building above the church entrance - from where its striking *en chamade* trumpets speak down the length of the church.

Dimensions

Width – c.6 metres

Depth – c.4 metres

Height to highest point – c. 6metres plus.

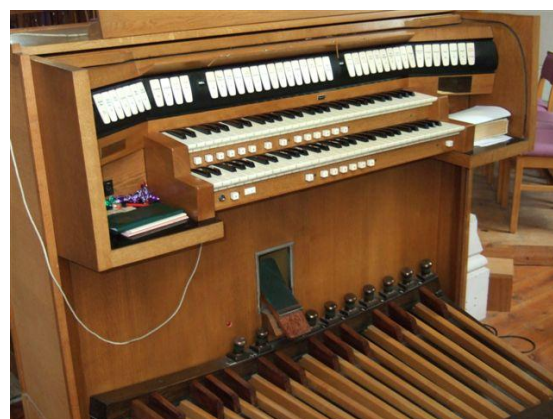
The organ is well maintained and used occasionally for concerts.
